Title: Honor, Service, and Salvation
Scripture: Hebrews 12:1-2

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Hebrews 12:1-2 Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

Big Idea: Honoring the legacy of the fallen means dropping our weights and sins and locking our gaze on Jesus.

I. Honor the legacy of the fallen by remembering the sacrifices they made.

Heb 12:1a Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses,

Everyone has the capacity for LDRSHIP, but not everyone answers the call.

II. Honor the legacy of the fallen by Continuing the fight with Courage.

Heb 12:1b (ESV) *let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,*

Everyone has the capacity to fight, but few will you endure with HONOR, COURAGE, and COMMITMENT.

III. Honor the legacy of the fallen by focusing on Christ.

Heb 12:2 looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

Everyone has the capacity to Aim High, but will you walk in INTEGRITY, SERVICE, and EXCELLENCE.
